Here's the rules

RULE 1

You may use any pattern(s) available for download from The Bead Coop in your entry.

RULE 2

Entries will be judged on originality, creativeness and uniqueness of design, finishing, embellishment and use of the pattern(s) in that design.

RULE 3

Entry deadline is March 1, 2003; all entries will be posted to a special area of The Bead Coop as they are received. From March 1, 2003 to April 1, 2003, open public voting will take place on the designs, with each person able to vote on one favorite in each category.

Categories will be

Junior Entrant

(12 and under)

Senior Entrant

(55 and over)

Open Professional

(Anyone who makes a portion of his or her income from teaching beadwork/jewelry classes, or finished jewelry items/designs)

Open Amateur

Male Entrant

Guys only

Female Entrant

Gals only

Multiple Patterns Used

(2 or more used in the same design)

RULE 4

An entrant can enter as many finished pieces as they wish, however, each finished piece can only be entered into one division. Each category will have it's own prizes/awards

RULE 5

All entrants must provide the name(s) of patterns used in the finished piece, as well as artist the pattern is by. In posting the photos for judging, the creator of the piece will be kept secret until the judging is done, and all entrants will get a number when they are submitted. There is no entry fee for participation in this contest!

RULE 6

All jpg's submitted for this contest become the property of The Bead Coop and can be used for advertising, and promotion as they see fit.

RULE 7

You must send your jpg (4 x 4, 100 resolution or better) to dbergs@designsbydeb.com . We'll take care of editing it to the proper size here. Remember, the visitors to the site will be voting according to the photos you submit, so be sure that they see your entry to the best quality possible!

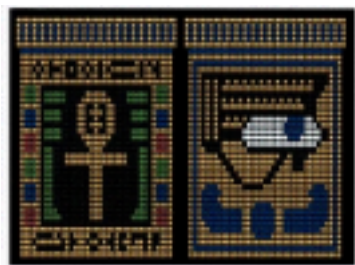
SANDS OF TIME DESIGNS

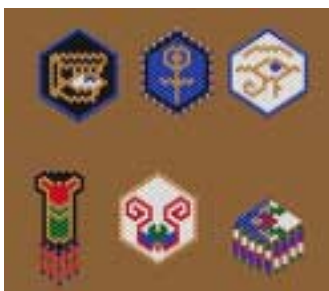
